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Sidewalk Chalk Gross Motor Obstacle Course



To create your own driveway gross motor obstacle course, you will need:

- chalk
- plenty of space on which to draw your obstacle course

You can create any designs and patterns that you would like, which means it can be different every time: zig zags, spirals, loops, shapes to hop into, lines to jump over, “balance” beams to maneuver by placing one foot in front of the other, and a hopscotch board.

You could incorporate [a chalk maze](#) into your driveway obstacle course, too. You can make your course as long or as short as you want. Go ahead and write some easy-to-decode words such as “hop,” “jump,” and “end” or “stop” along the route.
